Jim has taught at FDIC for 24 years, the Firehouse Expo, Worchester Safety & Survival, and several other shows across the country.

Chief Crawford knew Jimmy like a brother. Working along side each other on the fire ground, teaching on the circuit, but most importantly at the family level.

This class will revolve around real world incidents and the Rapid Intervention skills needed to perform on today's fire ground.
